



## Health & Safety Coordinator - Wolverine, Yukon

Yukon Zinc Corporation has an immediate need for an experienced **Health & Safety Coordinator** at its Wolverine Mine project in the southeast Yukon Territory.

### Responsibilities

Reporting to the Health & Safety Superintendent, the Safety Coordinator will play a key role in site-wide safety initiatives and programs, with particular emphasis on underground mining operations. More specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Promote a positive safety culture that includes active participation by employees and contractors.
- Participate in daily safety interactions, including performing safety inspection and auditing to ensure adherence to standards.
- Conduct required Industrial hygiene functions and testing.
- Inform and educate employees concerning health and safety standards.
- Facilitate required safety training for the mine site including safety meetings.
- Conduct drug and alcohol testing as required.
- Facilitate and participate in incident investigation and risk assessments as required.
- Involved as an emergency response team member and leading required training and mine rescue practices.
- Assist line management with understanding and interpretation of Yukon Zinc policies & procedures, Yukon Territories health & safety regulations and industry best practices.
- Be an active member of first aid response and hold required certification.

### Requirements

- Minimum 5 years experience in underground mining as a health and safety coordinator.
- A degree/diploma or equivalent work experience in health and safety
- Working knowledge of safety and health regulations in mining.
- OFA 3 equivalent or higher level of first aid and valid mine rescue certificate.
- Knowledge and experience in Industrial hygiene testing and reporting.
- Knowledge and experience of drug and alcohol testing and protocols.
- Knowledge in ergonomics and programs.
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written. along with advanced computer skills in Excel, Word, Powerpoint and Tap-root investigation software
- Valid driver licence, minimum class 5.
- Remote camp (northern climate) experience preferable.

Wolverine is an underground mine that will produce on average 1,700 tonnes per day run-of-mine feed when it goes into production, scheduled for the third quarter of 2010. The minesite is located almost midway between Ross River and Watson Lake on the Robert Campbell Highway and is approximately 250 km by air northeast of Whitehorse.
