



## Industrial Electrician - Wolverine Mine, Yukon

Yukon Zinc Corporation has an immediate need for an experienced **Industrial Electrician** at its Wolverine Mine project in the southeast Yukon Territory.

### Responsibilities

Initially intended to perform a 'bridging' function between installation and commissioning, this position is expected to transition to operations. More specific responsibilities include:

- Coordinate with contractors and vendors during the installation and commissioning of the power generating equipment and ancillary equipment necessary for mine operations.
- Provide leadership and assistance in the training of other operating personnel after commissioning and in the transition to operations.
- Assist in the development of safe work and operating procedures for surface electrical equipment.
- Perform on-going electrical and maintenance functions as a member of the Surface Operations group.
- Provide assistance to plant and underground electrical maintenance personnel, as may be required.

### Requirements

- Trade qualification as an Industrial Electrician. Interprovincial (Red Seal) certification preferred.
- Minimum 3-years experience in maintenance of diesel power generators (Caterpillar), control systems, transformers, and ancillary equipment.
- Stationary plant (mineral processing) and underground mine electrical installation and maintenance experience will be an asset.
- Excellent work ethics and demonstrated record of safety leadership.
- Proficient in Word, Excel, Email.
- Remote camp (northern climate) experience preferable.

Wolverine is a fly-in/fly-out underground mine operation that will produce on average 1,700 tonnes per day run-of-mine feed when it goes into production, scheduled for the third quarter of 2010. The minesite is located almost midway between Ross River and Watson Lake on the Robert Campbell Highway and is approximately 250 km by air northeast of Whitehorse.

This position will be on a rotational work schedule of 2 weeks in x 2 weeks out.
