Responsibilities

Reporting to the Surface Operations Superintendent the Electrical and Instrumentation Supervisor would be responsible for ensuring all electrical maintenance is carried out in a safe and effective manner. More specific responsibilities include:

- Co-ordinate and schedule the activities involving installation, repair and maintenance of electrical generation and distribution equipment
- Develop, implement and execute long range electrical and instrumentation maintenance plans
- Overseeing the troubleshooting of electrical and control systems
- Assist in the development of safe work and operating practices and procedures for all site Electrical Equipment
- Prepare work progress reports
- Liaise with Maintenance Planner to develop work scope and future planning requirements

Requirements

- Trade qualification as an Industrial Electrician. Interprovincial (Red Seal) certification preferred
- Minimum 3 – 5 years experience in diesel generation (Caterpillar), 4160V power distribution, mineral processing, DCS/ PLC control systems and underground mine electrical installation and maintenance
- Excellent work ethics and demonstrated record of safety leadership
- Proficient in Microsoft Office programs (Word, Excel, and Outlook Express)
- Remote camp (northern climate) experience preferable
