Responsibilities

Reporting to the Surface Operations Superintendent/Manager, the Surface Maintenance Planner plays a key role in the site-wide preventive maintenance:

- Develop and implement proactive preventive maintenance schedules.
- Plan scheduled shutdowns with involvement from other departments and with minimal disruption to operations as a whole.
- Provide input to long range planning schedules for maintenance and operations
- Interact with warehousing to ensure availability of required parts.
- Assist with analysis on rebuilds versus new equipment purchase decisions.
- Assist with understanding and projecting maintenance costs.

Requirements

- Minimum 3-years experience in plant maintenance planning, preferably in mining
- Trades qualification in Millwright, Heavy Duty Mechanical, Electrical or Carpentry
- Knowledge of diesel power generation, mobile equipment, electrical and building maintenance requirements will be an asset.
- Excellent work ethics and demonstrated record of safety leadership.
- Proficient in Word, Excel, Email.
- Prior experience with 4Site Maintenance Software would be definite asset.
- Valid driver licence, minimum class 5.

- Remote camp (northern climate) experience preferable.
