### **Responsibilities**

Our Millwrights play a key role on the processing plant team for ensuring safe, efficient, and effective operations. More specific responsibilities include:

- Inspect machinery and equipment to detect and investigate existing and potential irregularities and malfunctions.
- Adjust machinery and repair/replace defective parts.
- Install, align, dismantle, and move stationary machinery and mechanical equipment.
- Fabricate parts required during overhaul, maintenance or set-up of machinery.
- Work closely with the Maintenance Foreman and Maintenance Planner to schedule and perform routine maintenance.
- Assist in the development of safe work and operating procedures for Mill equipment.
- Demonstrate effective safety leadership within the Mill operating and maintenance team.

### **Requirements**

- Interprovincial (Red Seal) certification with mineral processing experience.
- Fabrication and welding skills.
- Demonstrated experience with the following equipment:
  - Solution, slurry, vacuum, positive displacement pumps, and tailings back fill systems
  - Jaw and cone crushers (with Trio engineered products will be an asset)
  - Vibrating screens and feeders
  - Conveyors and drive components
  - Rod, ball, and SMD vertical mills
  - Flotation, filtration (rotary and hydraulic press) & dewatering systems
  - Compressors, blowers, and HVAC systems.
