Responsibilities

Reporting to the Technical Services Superintendent, the Mine Planner will play a key role in the safe operations of the underground mine. More specific responsibilities include:

- Contribute to the development of the company safety culture
- Assist with mine design and provision of driving layouts.
- Oversee surveyors to ensure timely mark-ups and pick-ups.
- Conduct estimating and scheduling.
- Assist with long and short range mine planning.
- Coordinate stope extraction and backfill sequencing.
- Monitor compliance with ground control management plan.
- Prepare reports as required.

Requirements

- Mine Engineering related university degree and a minimum of 3 years of progressively responsible experience in underground mining; or an equivalent combination of education and experience
- Demonstrated record of safety leadership
- Computer literate in MS Office. Experience in CAD based modeling programs would be considered an asset
- Experience in development of a new underground mine operation will be an asset
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Able to work a rotational work schedule of 2 weeks in x 2 weeks out
- Consent to a pre-employment medical examination which includes a drug & alcohol screening

Wolverine is a "dry camp", fly-in/fly-out underground mine operation. The minesite is located midway between Ross River and Watson Lake on the Robert Campbell Highway and is approximately 280 km by air northeast of Whitehorse.
