### Responsibilities

- Participate in the development of short and long term planning of underground mining
- Direct and coordinate enforcement of mining laws and safety regulations
- Co-ordinate the activity of mine operations personnel, with emphasis on safety
- Consult with other managers to set production and development targets

### Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree in Mining Engineering and a minimum of 10 years experience in underground mining, at least 5 of which has been in senior supervision; or an equivalent combination of education and experience
- Experience in working with underground mining contractors
- Experience in development of a new underground mine operation will be an asset
- Effective written and verbal communications skills
- Strong conflict resolution and negotiation skills
- Consent to a pre-employment medical examination which includes a drug & alcohol screening

Wolverine is a "dry camp", fly-in/fly-out underground mine operation. The mine site is located midway between Ross River and Watson Lake on the Robert Campbell Highway and is approximately 280 km by air northeast of Whitehorse.
